The Institute is committed to Manage its Campus in accordance with responsibilities towards promoting sustainable environment. These responsibilities Can be demonstrated within the following areas: -

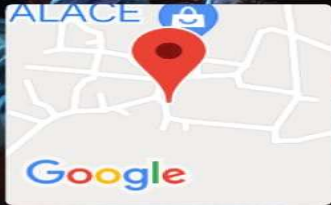
1. To create awareness regarding environmental policies amongst the students and the staff.

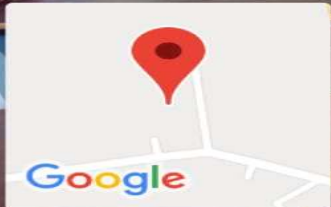
